

Our Philosophy



Wee Friends Creative Preschool provides an environment to improve, expand, and stimulate each child's growth in the following areas:

Cognitive—the process of thinking and doing

Physical—strengthening large and small muscles, and improving his/her coordination

Social- learning to live constructively with peers and adults, and to value his/her own rights and the rights of others.

Emotional—the ability to understand, to channel and express inner feelings. To talk rather than to act.

Self-concept—developing positive self identity and awareness, as well as pride in family and culture.

Language—increasing both listening and speaking skills.

Creativity—growth in ability to express inner creative impulses; through music, dance, and art experiences

Curiosity - wondering and seeking answers to questions, building courage to explore the world as it truly is.

Children who are three or four on or before September 1, 2008 (and are potty trained) are welcome to enroll in our program.
